Kashechewan, a Cree community of approximately 1,500 on the shore of James Bay in Northern Ontario, has been evacuated three times in the last 20 months due to flooding. sewage back up or water quality issues. For a brief period of time, residents of the community were living in temporary accommodation in several towns and cities as they awaited repairs on their homes and infra-

structures.

Many of the residents have since returned home but are being stretched financially in meeting their daily living costs. In an effort to help families in Kashechewan to

receive basic staples such as food and clothing, we have been able to join forces with the Emergency Relief and Distribution Organiza-



tion of the PAOC in transporting goods to Moosonee. The skids of supplies will be placed on a barge to make its way up James Bay to Kashechewan. Volume 1, Issue 1 November 2006.

Many years ago an elderly gentleman told me to get all the education that I could because it was easy to carry around. He was right. It is light.




His Word brings times of refreshing.
